### **Policies**

**Photographic Release:** Photographs of classes and students will be taken by TC Arts staff and representatives. Images may be used for marketing purposes including printed and social media, among others. Student and Parent/Guardian grant and convey unto Transylvania Community Arts Council (TC Arts) all rights, title, and interest in and to any and all photographic images, and video and audio recordings made by or on behalf of TC Arts during the Student's activities with TC Arts and the Arts Academy, including but not limited to, any royalties, proceeds, or other benefits derived from such photographs or recordings.

**Cancellations/Withdrawals/Refunds:** TC Arts reserves the right to cancel any class with insufficient enrollment and will refund 100% of your registration fee. Notification of class cancellations will be made at least three (3) calendar days prior to the first day of class.

Any request for withdrawal or cancellation by Parent/Guardian must be made in person or over the phone at least ten (10) business days before the start of the class(es) to be eligible for a TC Arts voucher. Email and voicemail withdrawal WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED and any voucher that would otherwise be due will be forfeited. If notification of withdrawal is not received at least 10 business days prior to the start of the class, all fees paid for the class will be forfeited.

**No monetary refunds will be given for a student's voluntary withdrawal.** Instead, a TC Arts voucher, less a \$50 processing fee, will be issued for future use.

WAIVER OF LIABILITY, MEDICAL RELEASE, & INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT: In consideration for Student being permitted by TC Arts to participate in the Arts Academy, Student and Parent/Guardian hereby waive, release, and discharge any and all claims and damages for personal injury, death, or property damage which Student and/or Parent/Guardian may sustain or which may occur as a result of Student's participation in these activities. Student and Parent/Guardian understand, acknowledge and agree that: (1) This release is intended to discharge in advance the employees, officers, directors and agents of TC Arts from and against any and all liability connected in any way with the Student's participation in activities at TC Arts; (2) Student and Parent/Guardian voluntarily request permission for Student to participate in activities at TC Arts; (3) Student and Parent/Guardian expressly and specifically assume any and all risks of injury, death, harm or property damage, and release and hold harmless TC Arts, its directors, officers, employees and agents from all liability for injury, illness, death, or property damage resulting from Student's participation in activities at TC Arts; (4) This waiver, release and assumption of risk is to be binding on the heirs and assigns of Student and Parent/Guardian; (5) Student and Parent/Guardian indemnify and hold TC Arts and its directors, officers, employees and agents harmless from any loss, liability, damage, cost or expense, including litigation, which TC Arts and/or its directors, officers, employees and agents may incur as a result of any injury and/or property damage which Student and/or Parent/ Guardian may sustain while participating in such activities; (6) Student and Parent/Guardian will make good any loss or damage or cost TC Arts and/or its directors, officers, employees and agents may have to pay if any litigation arises on account of any claim made by Student and/or Parent/Guardian and/or by anyone on Student's and/or Parent/Guardian's behalf; (7) In the event that Student requires medical or surgical treatment while under the supervision of TC Arts personnel in connection with the Arts Academy, such supervisor may authorize treatment; (8) Student and Parent/Guardian will pay all medical, hospital, or other expenses which Student and Parent/Guardian may incur as a result of such treatment:(10) activities and participation in

the Arts Academy are not childcare as defined by the State of North Carolina. Parent/Guardian certifies that Parent/Guardian has custody or is the legal guardian of Student by court order, and that Student is physically able to participate in the described activities. Student and Parent/Guardian have carefully read this Waiver of Liability, Medical Release, and Indemnification Agreement and fully understand its contents. Student and Parent/Guardian are aware that this is a release of liability and a contract between Student and Parent/Guardian and TC Arts, and that Student and Parent/Guardian sign it of their own free will.

**Behavior Policy:** To ensure a quality experience for all involved, TC Arts reserves the right to refuse/remove a student due to behavioral problems. If a situation arises and a student is asked to leave, class fees will be forfeited with no refund/voucher.

Fall 2021 Class Descriptions

### Weekdays:

Tuesday: October, 12, 19, 26, November 2, 9, 16 Art Through Our Senses (Ages 5-7)

In this beginning level art class, we will be exploring art and art-making through our senses. We will also learn about the work of famous artists and become inspired to create our own masterpieces! Each week will focus on a different sense/skill, which we will explore through music, movement, and art. Students will come away from the experience with tools they can use to increase their sense of self-awareness and resilience. This 6-week class will meet on Tuesday afternoons, from 3.45-5.15pm. Caren Stewart is the instructor for this class. The registration fee for this class is \$150.

### Wednesday: October 13, 20, 27, November 3, 10, 17, December 1, 8 Drawing and Painting (Ages 12-14)

This is a beginning guided drawing and painting class intended for <u>interested students</u> who want to experiment with a variety of media to produce several finished works of art. Come with an open mind and be ready to learn something new and have fun. A small sketchbook is required. This class will meet on Wednesday afternoons, from 3.45-5.15pm. Cindy Rehm is the instructor for this class. The registration fee for this 8-week class is \$200.

### Thursday: October 7, 14, 21, 28, November 4, 18 Introduction to Pottery (Ages 6-14)

TC Arts will offer a hand-building class for students ages 6 – 14. Students will primarily explore clay and create pottery pieces with hand-building techniques. They will also have the opportunity to observe and experience wheel-throwing. The class will meet on Thursday afternoons, from 4-5.15pm. The cost for this class is \$200, and includes clay, firing and all supplies. Nancy Frady is the instructor for this class.

### Saturdays:

### Saturday: October 16, 23, 30, November 6, 13, 20 Art Explorations (Ages 8-11)

We will create drawings, paintings and sculptures, using many fun and creative techniques. Come with an open mind and be ready to learn something new and have fun. We will surely get a bit messy at times so smocks are required! Art Explorations will meet on Saturday mornings, from 10-11.30am. Cindy Rehm is the instructor for this class. The registration fee is \$175.

## Saturday: October 2, 9, 16, 23, 30, November 6, 13, 20 Drawing with Billy Smith (Ages 16-22)

Learn from local artist Billy Smith! This 8-week class is for **interested students** who want to expand their drawing skills. A sketchbook is required. This class will meet on Saturday afternoons, from 12.30-2.30pm. The registration fee for this 8-week class is \$250.

Saturday: October 2, 9, 16, 23, 30 (Session 1)

Saturday: November 6, 13, 20, December 4, 11 (Session 2)

Fun with Animation and Storytelling (Ages 8-12)

Explore various media art forms, including puppetry, flip books, green screen, stop motion and video editing, as we collaborate to bring out the magic in your storytelling! Students must provide their own iPads/tablets or laptop. Fun with Animation will meet on Saturday mornings, from 10am to Noon. The instructor for this class is Michael Koz. The registration fee for this class is \$150.

Saturday: October 2, 9, 16, 23, 30 (Session 1)

Saturday: November 6, 13, 20, December 4, 11 (Session 2)

**Introduction to Cartooning (Ages 8-12)** 

Draw cartoon characters in this fun introductory cartooning class. Learn how to design your own characters, and construct fun facial features, eyes, hair, and costumes. A small sketchbook is required. Cartooning will meet on Saturday afternoons, from 12.30-2.30pm. The instructor for this class is Michael Koz. The registration fee for this class is \$150.

#### **Class Size Limitations**

All classes are limited to ten students per class, except Fun with Storytelling which is limited to 8 students per class.

### October 4, 11, 18, 25

### Digital Photography: The Basics (Ages 17+)

TC Arts Council will host a course on the basics of digital photography for adults ages 16 and older. The class will meet on Monday mornings, from 10am-12pm. This class is taught by Kathy King, the executive director of TC Arts. Students will need to bring their own digital cameras, preferably cameras with manual settings. The registration fee for this class is \$125.

### November 8, 15, 29, December 6 Digital Scrapbooking (Ages 17+)

TC Arts Council will host a course on digital scrapbooking for adults ages 16 and older. Learn how to create templates and layouts for your photos. The class will meet on Monday mornings, from 10am-12pm. This class is taught by Kathy King, the executive director of TC Arts. The registration fee for this class is \$125. Students will need to provide their own laptops with Photoshop Elements 2021 installed.

### **Adult Workshops**

#### October 8

### **Acrylic Pouring (Ages 17+)**

Acrylic Pouring is a painting technique where acrylic paint is mixed with a pouring medium and then poured onto a surface in a variety of ways. Have you seen all the YouTube videos and wanted to try it? Have you tried it, but been frustrated by a muddy mess? Come learn the ins and outs of working acrylics in this fun and fluid way! We will cover different pouring mediums, paint mixing and consistency, different techniques for applying and moving paint, curing and sealing your work, troubleshooting, and more! This class will also have many demos and, of course, play time for you to create your own pieces to take home.

This workshop will meet from 10am-2pm on Friday, October 8<sup>th</sup>, and will be led by Robyn Crawford. The registration fee for this class is \$90, which includes all materials.

### October 15

### Hand Printed Papers (Ages 17+)

Discover the wonderful world of mono printing using a gelatin plate and acrylics! We will play with textures, colors, and print surfaces, as we create some amazing papers for collage, cards, handmade books, art journals, and whatever mixed media art your heart desires. Loads of tips and techniques will be shared, with lots of time for discovery and hands-on creating. All materials will be provided. Just wear old clothes and come ready to have fun. You should also pack a snack or lunch. We will take a break ½ way through.

This workshop will meet from 10am-2pm on Friday, October 15<sup>th</sup>, and will be led by Robyn Crawford. The registration fee for this class is \$90, which includes all materials.
